Jilin Animation Institute (JAI) comprises 15 teaching units, including the School of Animation Art, School of Comics, School of Games, School of Design and Product, etc., offering 32 undergraduate programs such as Animation, Comics, Digital Media Art, Visual Communication Design. There are more than 13,000 students on campus.

Adhering to the characteristic of "open and international" education, the institute has established intercollegiate cooperative relations with 97 institutions in 23 countries and regions worldwide. More than 500 global industry experts have been invited as visiting professors, conducting activities such as lectures and workshops throughout the year. It is currently a member of international industry associations including ASIFA, Cumulus, ICoD, and CILECT.

The institute has successively hosted more than 60 large-scale forums such as the China (Jilin) Animation Conference, China·Jilin International Animation and Game Forum, China-US Comics Summit Forum, and Sino-French Cultural Spring Exchange Season. It regularly hosts and organizes international exhibitions and competitions all year around, with faculty and student works winning (or being shortlisted) more than 300 international awards.



The campus environment is beautiful and the infrastructure is complete. There are two campuses in total. Campus life is rich and colorful, with diverse club activities. Each year, various cultural performances, sports meets, cultural experience projects, social practices and other activities are held, which are highly popular among students.

| <ul style="list-style-type: none">1. Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens holding valid foreign passports. Chinese mainland, Hong Kong, Macao, and Taiwan residents who have emigrated abroad and wish to apply as international students, or those whose parents (one or both) are Chinese citizens and have settled abroad, the applicant must provide proof of foreign nationality for at least 4 years, and have a record of actually living in a foreign country for more than 2 years within the last 4 years (before April 30, 2025) (actually residing abroad for at least 9 months in a year can be counted as 1 year).2. Applicants must have good moral character, abide by Chinese laws and regulations, as well as various school rules and regulations, respect Chinese people's customs, have a high school diploma with good academic performance, and be in good health.3. 4. Application Process

- (1) **Online Application:** Applicants should submit relevant application materials to *gjlxxy@jlai.edu.cn* within the specified time.
- (2) **Qualification Review:** After receiving the application materials, the institute will organize a qualification review. If the submitted information or materials fail the review, the applicant must resubmit the relevant information or materials promptly as required.
- (3) **Interview:** For applicants who pass the qualification review, the institute will organize remote interviews or written tests (professional proficiency tests) as needed. Specific arrangements will be notified separately.
- (4) **Admission:** For applicants who pass the qualification review and professional proficiency test will receive an "Admission Letter" and a "Visa Application For Study in China (JW202 Form)". Overseas students should apply for a Chinese visa at the embassy or consulate of the People's Republic of China in their home country. Foreign applicants who already hold a valid residence permit in China can directly contact the International Students Management Office of the institute.
- (5) **Enrollment:** Complete the registration procedures at the International Exchange School of Jilin Animation Institute within the specified time according to the specific requirements of the "Admission Letter" and "Admission Information". Upon enrollment, the school will review the applicant's information and materials for admission qualification. In case of violations, fraud, or other irregularities, the admission qualification will be canceled upon verification.

5. Insurance for Studying in China:

In accordance with relevant regulations of the Ministry of Education of China, international students must purchase insurance for studying in China during their study period. Students should purchase it on their own before registration(Study Abroad Insurance Website:



<https://www.lxbx.net/home>). Those who fail to purchase medical insurance as required will not be registered by the school.
